If you have not let me know yet what cruises you will be going on, you must do it ASAP because we have only a limited number of reservations and some of the marinas are already booked.

If you are going to go on the entire vacation cruise, you must send a \$100.00 deposit check to Jane in order to reserve your place. Some of the marinas need an advance reservation.

The Memorial Day cruise to Baltimore Inner Harbor is almost sold out. You must let me know by 5/1 if you are going. We will have a van to take people to the different openings if you want to go.

The Fairlee Creek Cruise is on June 21-23. If you want to go you must call and make your own reservations. We have a club reservation for 10 boats, but they need a call and deposit from each person. Tell them you are from Top of the Bay. Their phone number is **1-800-LANDING**
