### Recipe of the Month: Marinated Carrots

#### Ingredients

1 lb. carrots, scraped and thinly sliced

1/3 cup chopped green pepper

1/3 cup sugar

1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1/3 cup chopped onion

1/3 cup vinegar

3 tablespoons vegetable oil

1/4 teaspoon prepared mustard

#### Directions

Cook carrots in a small amount of boiling water about 5 minutes or until crisp-tender; drain. Combine carrots, onion and green pepper. Combine remaining ingredients in a jar. Cover tightly and shake vigorously. Pour over vegetables; toss lightly with a fork. Cover and chill overnight. 4-6 servings.
