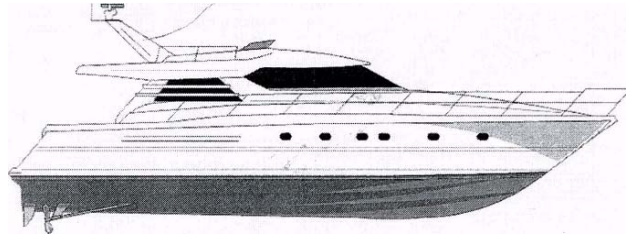

### **Marinated Carrots**

**1 LB. carrots – cut in sticks (I used two 1 LB. bags of baby carrots – did not double other ingredients).**

**1 large onion chopped**

**1 green pepper chopped**

**1 can tomato soup            Cook carrots until tender**

**To soup add:**

**2/3 cup sugar**

**1/2 cup oil**

**3/4 cup vinegar**

**1/2 tsp. dry mustard**

**2 T. Worcestershire sauce**

**salt & pepper to taste (I didn't use).    ADD carrots, onion, & pepper. Marinate overnight  
put carrots in while warm**
